

Press Statement By The Secretary For Foreign Affairs On The Government Of Zimbabwe's Postponement Of The Convening Of The Common Market For Eastern And Southern Africa (COMESA) Summit.

Due to the necessity to fulfill Constitutional requirements as a result of the recently held harmonised elections, the Government of Zimbabwe has decided to postpone convening of the Common Market for Eastern and Southern African (COMESA) Summit to a later date. This follows the realisation that the original Summit dates (2-15 May 2008) might coincide with the uncompleted electoral processes.

The Zimbabwe Government will announce the new dates for the Summit after the necessary consultations have been done.
